TOWN OF ELGIN REZONING PROCEDURES

1. <u>Application</u>: An application for rezoning must be filed with the Town at least 7 days prior to a scheduled meeting of the Planning Commission, which is held on the ______ of each month. Application forms are available upon request at Town Hall.

2. <u>Fee</u>: An application fee of \$240 must accompany all rezoning applications.

3. <u>Planning Commission Meeting</u>: The applicant will be advised of the time and place of the meeting of the Planning Commission. The applicant or a representative is asked to be present at the meeting in order to answer questions concerning his/her application.

4. <u>Council Meeting</u>: After the application has been reviewed by the Planning Commission, it is then forwarded to Town Council.

5. <u>Public Hearing</u>: A public hearing will be scheduled and held by Town Council on each rezoning application, to provide an opportunity for interested citizens to comment.

The Zoning Administrator will have published a Legal Notice in the newspaper of the public hearing. The notice will appear in the paper not less than 15 days prior to the date of the public hearing.

6. <u>Notification of Council's Actions</u>: After the final reading by Town Council, the applicant will be notified of Council's actions.

7. <u>Zoning Change Posted</u>: After final action by Town Council, the proposed map change, if approved, will be recorded on the Official Zoning Map(s) by the Zoning Administrator.
