### **PUBLIC FORUM GUIDELINES**

1. Public Forum:
  - is an opportunity for members of the public to share information with Council.
  - is not a time for debate with or questions and answers from Council.
  - is a time for Council to receive input.
  - is not a time for Council response.In short, during Public Forum, Council will LISTEN to public comment, but not COMMENT on public comment.
2. Offensive and inappropriate comments will not be tolerated, and comments should be limited to statements and rhetorical questions.
3. If a group would like to speak to the Council, we request that a spokesperson be selected, and that this person indicates the group he/she is representing on the Sign-Up Sheet and in his/her comments.
4. Public Forum is a time to discuss issues, not individuals. Other avenues exist for individual personnel complaints.
5. Public Forum period is limited to (30) minutes with (5) minutes maximum per individual speaker.
