## **PUBLIC FORUM GUIDELINES**

- 1. Public Forum:
  - -is an opportunity for members of the public to share information with Council.
  - -is not a time for debate with or questions and answers from Council.
  - -is a time for Council to receive input.
  - -is not a time for Council response.

In short, during the Public Forum, Council will LISTEN to public comment but not COMMENT on public comment.

- 2. Offensive and inappropriate comments will not be tolerated, and comments should be limited to statements and rhetorical questions.
- 3. If a group would like to speak to the Council, we request that a spokesperson be selected, and that this person indicates the group he/she is representing on the Sign-Up Sheet and in his/her comments.
- 4. Public Forum is a time to discuss issues, not individuals. Other avenues exist for individual personnel complaints.
- 5. The Public Forum period is limited to (30) minutes with (5) minutes maximum per individual speaker.
